December 12-14 Campout

Troop 210 has reserved Adirondacks #3 at Camp Miakonda for a campout on the weekend of December 12-14. Adirondacks are 3-sided shelters on concrete slabs with 2 bunk beds (no mattresses), arranged with the open side of the shelters facing a central fire pit. Scouts can either sleep in the Adirondack shelters or build a Camp Alaska style shelter with a buddy plus try out whatever prepared meals they bring. You will also be able to work on a number of outdoor, map & compass, or other Scout skills.

Meet directly at Camp Miakonda Friday night any time after 6 pm. Teams of Scouts should bring the appropriate Camp Alaska gear, meals, and if planning to make your own shelter, shelter materials.

When: Friday, December 12, starting at 6:00 pm and ending Sunday, December 14. Note that you can elect to stay just one night. Parents, please be prompt picking up your Scouts.

Cost: \$15.00 per Scout

What to Bring: Tent camping gear as listed in your Scout handbook. Scouts must bring (3) of their own simple meals of a Camp Alaska type that can be easily cooked on an open fire or by adding hot water. The Troop will provide a Friday night snack and simple Sunday breakfast. Bring a ground pad even if you plan to sleep in the Adirondack shelters, all eating utensils, and the clothing/outdoor gear appropriate for the expected weather.

Activities: Map & compass training; Pioneering; geocaching; axemanship; fire building; Camp Alaska preparation
