September Campout @ Adams Conservation Club



Troop 210 will conduct our annual “back to Scouting” campout at the Adams Township Conservation Club on King Road the weekend of September 11-13. All Troop 210 Scouts and families are invited to a campfire dinner Saturday evening, September 12, *even if your Scout does not camp with us for the weekend*. Families are encouraged to bring a dish or dessert to pass for 6-8 people.

Where: Adams Conservation Club lake, on the east side of King Road. Use gate #4.

When: Friday, Sept. 11, thru Sunday, Sept. 13. Meet directly at the Adams Conservation Club lake any time Friday night after 6 pm. Scouts can be picked up by 9 am Sunday.

Time: Families may visit from 5–10 pm on Saturday. Dinner will start no later than 6 pm. Families may leave earlier if needed.

What to Bring: Yourself, your families, folding chairs, drinks. The Troop will provide burgers, hot dogs, home fries, table service, and lemonade. Also bring tent camping gear as listed in your Scout handbook, bug spray, poncho, canteen or water bottle, eating utensils, and clothing/outdoor gear appropriate for the expected weather. If you plan to fish, bring your own gear.

Do not bring: cell phones, electronics, snacks, food, candy, pop, pets, etc.

Program: Rifle shooting will be done indoors with .22's. Fishing and kayaking in the lake will be available depending upon the weather. Note that life vests will be provided ***and*** required for kayaking. Emcees will plan and present a campfire to include stories, campfire songs, and skits for our visitors.
