Troop Lock-In – January 9/10

The annual Troop lock-in is scheduled at the church starting at 6 pm on Friday, January 9 running until 7:30 am Saturday morning. Scouts may invite (1) friend with a completed permission slip.

Cost is \$10 per person for pizza and pop. Scouts that want to go to *Sky Zone* from 6:30 to 8 need to bring \$24.00 extra for the 1-1/2 hour session, complete an on-line Skyzone liability waiver, and have the official Sky Zone socks. Please do not bring cell phones, video games or other electronic devices. Bring a snack to share. A flyer with more information, permission slips, etc. is available online and at Troop meetings.

Camp Alaska – January 16-18

The (4) required weeks of cold weather camping training for Camp Alaska were completed at the December 16 Troop meeting. Makeup training sessions will be held on Jan. 6 and 13. *1st time* CA campers must bring their gear in for inspection prior to camping to one of those meetings. ***Scouts may attend the campout without doing Camp Alaska.*** They may stay both nights in the cabin that has been reserved, observe the Camp Alaska participants in action, work on advancements, and learn/prepare to participate another year.

Camp Alaska begins in the woods at the Pioneer Scout Reservation immediately upon arrival at camp on Friday night. With luck, the temperature will drop below 0°F at some point during our 24 hour adventure and we will earn a ***Below Zero*** segment!!

Cost is \$25.00. All Scouts doing Camp Alaska in the woods must meet Friday night, January 16, ***at 4:00 pm*** at Providence Lutheran, packed, and be ready to hike out into the woods as soon as the Troop arrives at PSR. Pack a separate bag with clothing, shoes and gear for Saturday night in the cabin. The rest of the Troop will meet at Providence Lutheran church at 6:00 and leave by 6:30 pm. The Troop should return to the church parking lot no later than 11 am Sunday.

Spaghetti Dinner & Court of Honor – January 20

The annual spaghetti dinner fundraiser for Providence Lutheran church runs from 5 – 6:30 pm in the Family Life Center on Tuesday, January 20. This is an important way for the Troop to thank the church for its support of Scouting. Adult and Scout help to cook, serve, bus, and cleanup is needed! The Scouts BSA Advancement Committee has made thoughtful updates to over 80 merit badges based on feedback from Scout leaders, subject matter experts, and current trends in technology, safety, and outdoor education. These updates will help Scouts explore modern career paths and hobbies, develop practical skills, and engage with current topics while maintaining the quality and tradition of the Scouting advancement program. Key updates include expanded career exploration, enhanced safety and outdoor ethics plus modernized content and skills to reflect current technology, safety practices and knowledge.

NOTE: Scouts that have already started a merit badge may opt to finish using the old requirements.
