Dorchester International Brotherhood Camporee – May 9-11 - Cost: \$100

All Dorchester forms are due to Mr. J. no later than **Thursday, May 1**. The Canadian Medical form can be filled out by a parent. The Troop leaves for the Dorchester International Brotherhood Jamboree on Friday, May 9, at 8:30 am, returning by about 3 pm Sunday. Meet at Providence Lutheran at 8:00 am. Wear your Class A uniform and bring your Troop 210 sweatshirt. Remaining key dates:

Make sure you bring the following items on Friday, May 9:

- Spending money for use at Dorchester for mementos, snacks, etc. Note that the Troop has included in the fee up to \$15 per meal per Scout for fast food lunches on the way up and on the return trip. Scouts wanting meals that cost more than that should plan on bringing extra money specifically for those meals. Do not bring any food or snacks with you.
- Any extra patches that you would like to trade. The Troop will provide about (15) patches for each Scout to start with.
- Wear only Troop 210 hoodies & class B's at the event. The Troop will bring extras.
- Your passport or passport card, if it was not turned in by the April 29 Troop meeting.

Electronic devices are *permitted to be used on the drive up and back as long as they do not interfere with the driver's concentration or sanity*. They must remain in the vehicles upon arrival.

Medical forms and remaining Summer Camp fees are due that night. An ice cream social will be held immediately afterwards. Please bring an ice cream dessert to pass for about 8 people. The meeting will start promptly at 7 pm.

Updated BSA Medical Forms For Summer Camp are Due by June 3

BSA medical forms must be updated annually and are good for one year from the date of the exam. An updated form can be turned in at any time during the year. Whenever a Scout receives an exam, ask the physician to complete Part C and turn a new completed form to a Troop leader. Parts A, B1, & B2 can be filled out by parents. Part C is required for summer camp but *must* be filled out by a physician.

When turning in an updated form, don't forget to include copies of both sides of your medical insurance card and to have your son sign the front.

June Troop Meetings

Troop meetings will continue thru the end of June. They are voluntary and the focus will be to prepare for summer camp and to help younger Scouts advance to their next rank. The next scheduled Troop meeting after June 24 is Tuesday, August 26.
