Pack 144 collected another 300+20 items, for a grand total of 1,541 food items and 94 personal hygiene items. The food and personal hygiene items will help needy local families for several months. *Great job again Scouts!!!*

Camp Alaska Training Begins on November 25

Camp Alaska is set for the weekend of January 16-18 at Camp Pioneer. Scouts that want to participate in Camp Alaska *must* undergo 4 weeks of cold weather training at Troop meetings. First time participants must bring their packed gear in to have it inspected at the January 6 or January 13 Troop meetings. The Troop has again reserved the old Handicrafts building. Scouts that do not wish to participate in the 24 hour outdoor Camp Alaska challenge may stay in the cabin both nights. Alternate activities will be set up for non-Camp Alaska participants.

Note that this year there will be a Camp Alaska shake down campout in the Adirondacks of Camp Miakonda on the weekend of Dec. 12-14. This is an opportunity for teams to test shelter designs, food selection/prep, gear, etc.
