

## Troop 210 2024 Summer Camp - Parent's Info -



- The Troop will meet to leave for camp on Sunday morning, June 30, at 11 am in the east Providence Lutheran parking lot. Make sure your Scout has eaten a good lunch since we won't eat at camp until dinner time. Scouts should have their gear packed so that it can be easily carried a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile, Scouts must wear their class A uniforms, minus neckerchiefs.
- Troop 210 will be at the **Crockett** campsite for the entire week.
- Scouts are responsible for their own money. Advise them to spread their spending out over the week. This year, Scouts can get *cash cards* for use only at camp. They can be filled & refilled by parents as desired.
- Like last year, there is no *Parents' Night* scheduled for mid-week on Wednesday night, July 3. There are also no visitors allowed in camp during the week unless specifically requested. Only registered Scout leaders with updated Michigan background checks are allowed in camp.
- Scouts will be allowed to call and talk to parents on Wednesday night upon request to adult leaders.
- The Troop *emergency contact person* (ECP) for the whole week is Mr. Schultz @ 276-3209. Please call the designated Troop ECP before trying to call the camp directly or any of the adult Troop leaders at camp. The ECP will call us to relay any important information and we in turn will notify them of any information related to severe weather, schedule changes, Scout issues, etc.
- Do not take your son out of camp for any reason without prior arrangement and knowledge of adult Troop leaders. This could result in an emergency "lost Scout" camp-wide search until the Scout is located.
- Do not let your son take food, cell phones, electronic games, computers, radios, i-pads, tablets, or any other electronic devices to camp.
- If you are picking up your son and/or helping carpool on Saturday, July 6, please arrive at camp no later than 9:00 am.
